“After Stanley?” was the most common response on hearing the name of the most handsome, amiable, original, and talented dog of all time – at least in the eyes of his owner, British fashion photographer and filmmaker Sean Ellis.

KUBRICK THE DOG is a very personal scrapbook and a tribute to Kubrick who, with his natural elegance, posed with many celebrities included in the book. It compiles Ellis’ best photos of the dog’s 12-year life, from a clumsy puppy to a grey-haired adult marked by illness. A fan of both Ellis and Kubrick, British fashion designer Stella McCartney wrote a eulogy prefacing a photographic homage that will melt the heart of dog lovers and fashionistas alike.

Sean Ellis (*1970 in Brighton, UK) belongs to the new generation of fashion photographers known for cinematically-staged images. He has worked for magazines such as *iD*, *The Face*, *Dazed and Confused*, and *Vogue*. He develops ad campaigns for Jean Paul Gaultier, Nike, H&M, Samsung, and Hugo Boss among others; he shoots music videos, short films – *Cashback* (2004) was nominated for an Oscar – and, most recently, the psychological thriller *The Broken*.

Kubrick (1998-2009) was a Hungarian Vizsla and an integral party of Ellis’ shooting team. He died of cancer.

Stella McCartney (*1971 in London), British fashion designer, has launched joint ventures with Chloé, the Gucci Group, H&M and others. In 2000 she designed Madonna’s wedding dress.
